TEMPORARY FLIGHT RESTRICTIONS.
Over Coolock Crown Paints Factory, Dublin City
Saturday 27th July

- 1 The Minister of Transport acceding to a request from The Department of Justice for reasons related to security, has issued a direction to the Irish Aviation Authority to establish an area of temporary restricted airspace (TRA) within which flight restrictions shall apply as detailed hereafter.

- 2 **Temporary Restricted Area (TRA)** Over Coolock Crown Paints Factory, Dublin City.

Lateral limits: Circle radius 1NM centred on 53°23'34.6"N 006°11'38.4"W (see chart at appendix A)

Vertical limits: Surface to 600FT.

Duration: Saturday 27th July.

Airspace Classification: The airspace within this TRA shall be ICAO Class C.

- 3 **Flight Restriction Details.** UAS Operations are not permitted within the TRA, except where authorised by the controlling authority, Department of Justice.
- 4 **Exemptions.** State UAS, UAS of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS Aircraft Operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction including UAS authorised by the controlling authority, Department of Justice.
- 5 **Controlling Authority Permission - Application Procedure.**

For flights which wish to operate within the TRA for which Controlling Authority permission is required a request should be made at least 4 hours in advance of departure to the Department of Justice as follows:

- download and fill in full the application form at appendix B
- attach the application form to an email and send to COflights@justice.ie
- include in the subject line the text **TRA Applications**.

If you do not include the text ***TRA Applications*** as the subject line your request will not be processed. You will receive an automatic reply to your email application-**THIS IS NOT AN APPROVAL**. The appropriate permission if granted will be relayed to the applicant with an approval number.

6 Warning

Unmanned Aircraft Systems operated in breach of TRA restrictions may be subject to seizure by An Garda Síochána as evidence for potential prosecution and in the interest of Aviation Safety (Unmanned Aircraft Systems means an unmanned aircraft and the equipment to control it remotely).

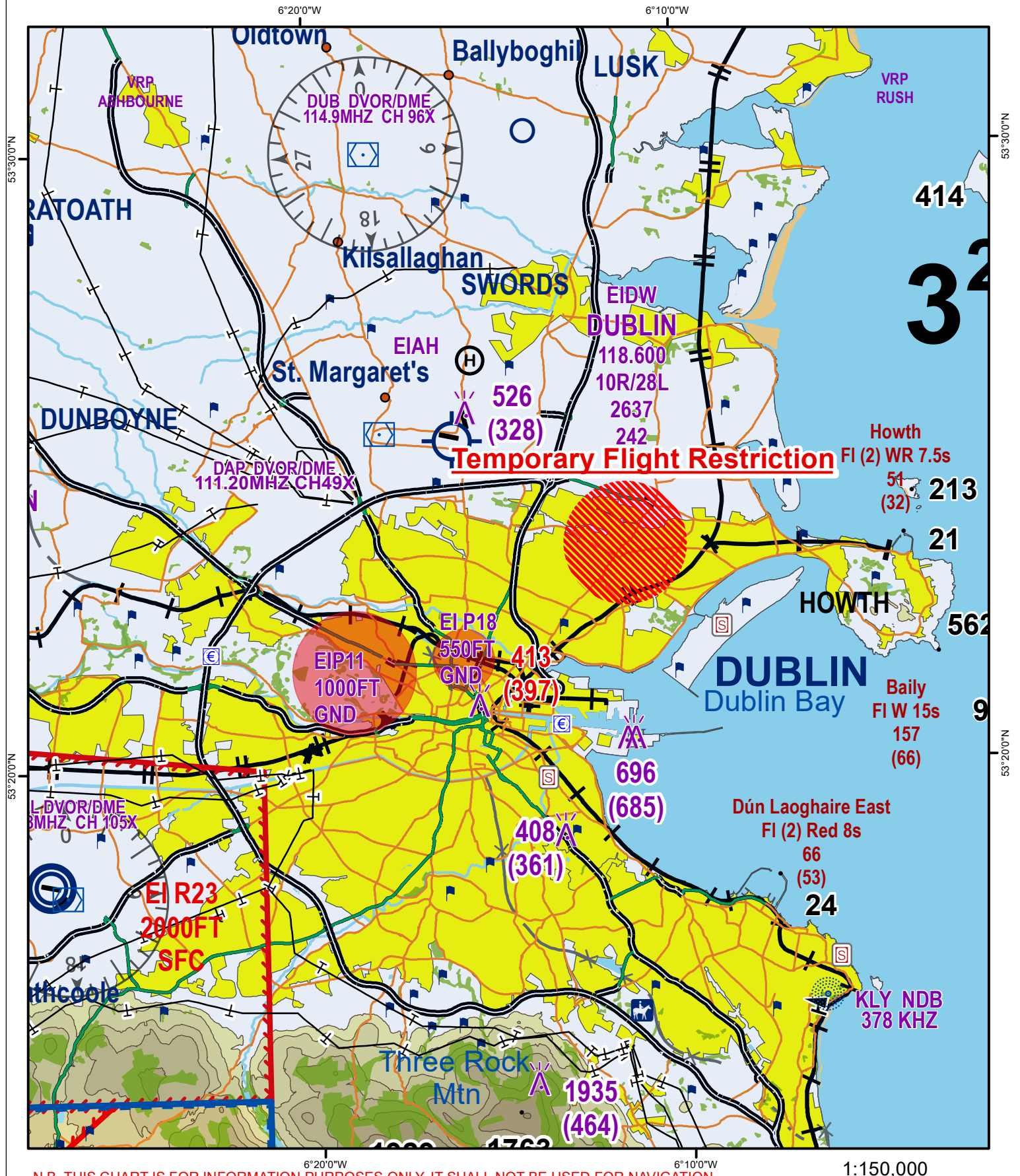
Pursuant to Article 13 of S.I. 24 of 2023, where there is a suspected breach of the EASA Regulations, or the Order (S.I. 24 of 2023), a member of An Garda Síochána may, in accordance with Section 7 of the Criminal Justice Act 2006, detain a UAS.

Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, granted to civil general air traffic by the Authority, are not valid within this Temporary Restricted Areas during the period cited.

- 7 NOTAMs.** NOTAMs will be issued in due course to notify of the activation of the TRAs.
