



**Flight Restriction in the vicinity of Galway Racecourse
Ballybrit, County Galway
Monday 29th July to Sunday 04th August inclusive 2024**

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 and 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Standardised Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923/2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows: -

A temporary restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of aircraft and rockets as defined in S.I. No. 25 of 2023, including Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) as defined in S.I. No. 24 of 2023 and European Commission Regulation (EU) 2019/947, shall apply in the vicinity of Galway Racecourse, Ballybrit, County Galway, in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits:	Circle radius of 0.75NM centred on 53° 17' 41" N, 008° 59' 41" W.
Vertical limits:	SFC to 1500 feet AMSL
Duration:	The period of the restriction shall be from 0900hrs UTC to 1900hrs UTC daily from Monday 29 th July to Sunday 04 th August 2024 inclusive.

The Purpose of the TRA:

The purpose of the TRA is to ensure the safety of aircraft operating to and from the Galway Racecourse and of other air traffic operating in the vicinity at Ballybrit, County Galway in the period cited.

Airspace Classification & Communication Service:

The airspace contained within the TRA is classified as ICAO Class G. The TRA is located within the Shannon Flight Information Region (FIR). There is no dedicated communications service within the TRA or HAMMS. For flights operating to and from the TRA, Air Traffic Services, as appropriate, are provided by AirNav Ireland at Shannon ACC (AIP refers).

Flight Restrictions & Exemptions:

a. Flights Permitted.

- i. State aircraft, aircraft of the Irish Coastguard Service and HEMS aircraft operators employed on an operational mission shall be exempt from the restriction.
- ii. Subject to any decision by the Flight Operations Department of the Irish Aviation Authority to the contrary, the airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by aircraft authorised by the event organisers (Galway Racecourse Ltd.).

b. Flights not permitted.

- i. All other aircraft are not permitted.
- ii. Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions, other than those listed at '**a. Flights Permitted**' granted to civil general air traffic by the Authority, are not valid within the TRAs during the periods cited.
- iii. Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) including drones and rockets, may not operate within the TRAs without specific written permission from the Flight Operations Department and event organisers (Galway Racecourse Ltd).
- iv. UAS's may be subject to seizure by An Garda Síochána as evidence for potential prosecution and in the interest of aviation safety.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course by the AIS office to notify of the TRA activation.

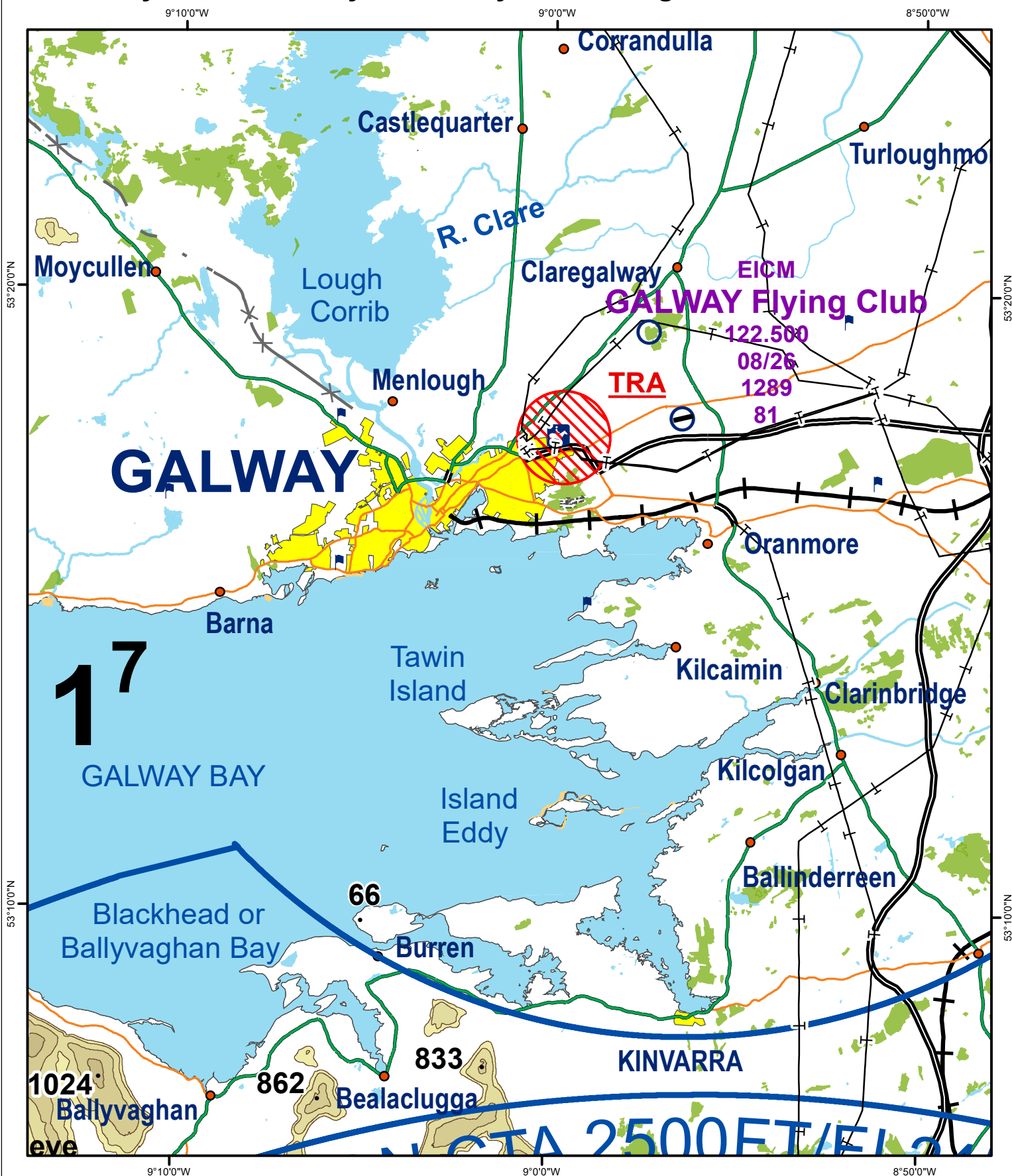
